



## Community Project Month May 2018

Another successful Community Projects Month was completed in May. The participating groups received \$25,314 in directed donations this year. The groups earned an additional \$5,062 in top-up grants from the Pinawa Foundation (shown in bold). This is a 25% increase in donations over 2017.
