She has coached Junior High Girls' Basketball as well as Bunny Rabbits. And Gladys Guthrie Scholarship (\$1,500) to Emi Rasmussen

Gladys Guthrie was one of the first nurses in Pinawa Hospital and an excellent example of the most important principle of the nursing profession; according to those in your care value, dignity, and kindness. This memorial scholarship in her memory has been established by her family to be presented to a deserving student entering nursing or a related field of health care.

Emi has shown her interest in leadership from Grade School onwards. She was part of Super Squad at FW Gilbert School. She participated in high school sports and served as team captain for both volleyball and basketball since Grade 10. She coached Junior High Girls' basketball for 2019 & 2020.
