The Pinawa Foundation Scholarship goes to the student who has participated in the school community on student council, volunteer coaching. sports teams and YIP. Girl Guides provided more opportunities for volunteer work and taught her valuable life skills. This year's award was presented to Scotlynd (Scottie) McKay who plans to pursue a career in animal health technology at Lakeland College in Alberta.

Gladys Guthrie was one of the first nurses in Pinawa Hospital and an excellent example of the most important principle of the nursing profession; according to those in your care value, dignity and kindness.

This memorial scholarship in her memory has been established by her family to be presented to a deserving student entering nursing or a related field of health care.

This award was presented to Carmen Sandul who plans to pursue a career in occupational therapy or physiotherapy at the University of Winnipeg. Carmen participated in high school sports (volleyball and soccer) as well as ringette. She is a certified lifeguard. Girl Guides offered her experience of volunteer work at the hospital, the Ironwood and highway

clean up. LIVE opened her to opportunities to fundraise to help other charities such as the Salvation Army and Craig Street Cats.

Foundation Hosts AGM

We would like to thank everyone that attended our 13th Annual General Meeting on June **20, 2023.** We were very excited to be able to have our first in-person AGM since 2019. The past year was very busy, and we were pleased to share our story with all of you.

Chris Saunders, our Chairman, gave a short presentation about the past year. He announced that the Foundation had exceeded our giving milestone of granting over \$1 Million to groups in Pinawa since 2010. Carol Findlay, the Foundation's treasurer, presented our year-end financials (endowed funds total \$1.5 Million).

After the presentation, grants totaling \$2,500 were awarded by the Youth in Philanthropy (YIP) Group from the high school, to 6 projects:

FW Gilbert Robotics Club – \$500 for radio/blue tooth-controlled robot building and coding kits for grade 1-6 Shirley's Kitchen – \$250 for kitchen stock pot, hand blender, and small utensils. Survivor's Hope – \$500 for signage, banner, and a canopy tent. Pinawa Hospital – \$500 for replacement wheelchairs Pinawa Arena Board – \$250 for Zamboni maintenance Daycare – \$500 for a baby area change table.

The Foundation would like to thank the YIP Group and their mentor Lisa Krupka for another successful year.

Carol Findlay then announced the results of our **Community Project Month Program from May 2023**. This year, we raised over \$88,497 for 14 projects, including the 40% top up provided by the Foundation (community donations of **\$69,172.33** and a stretch of **\$19,324.69**)

It is exciting to see 4 groups received the maximum grant for their fundraising efforts. We hope to see more groups receive the full grant in 2024.

EMCA received **\$5,000** for their 50th anniversary celebrations.

In total, the Foundation granted over \$111,000 at our AGM this year. **Thank you Pinawa for all your support**.
