Definitions and conditions.

- 1. It is the intent of the Foundation Directors that gifts for endowment should be left intact indefinitely ("in perpetuity" and forever) and only the income from the endowment spent on charitable causes. However, should a situation arise, beyond the control of the Foundation, that makes it impossible to continue with the declared intent of the donor either in relation to the lifetime of the endowment or to the exact target specified for the income then the Foundation will use its best judgment to satisfy the wishes of the donor as fully as is possible.
- 2. The Foundation assures donors that for at least the first three years from the date of incorporation, the income resulting from endowed gifts will be used for charitable purposes in its entirety and will not be used for administration, advertising, or overheads. The Directors will personally ensure that expenses are covered by other non-endowed gifts.
- 3. Tax rules ensure that accumulating funds are disbursed in a timely fashion. A non-endowed gift must be disbursed no later than the calendar year following the donation, and each year the Foundation must disburse, in addition, a sum equivalent to 3.5% of all its assets.
