The Foundation has had another busy year. Over the year, we distributed over \$132,000 to support numerous local projects. Much of this funding comes from our endowment fund, now over \$1.62 Million, allowing us to continue to support the community for years to come. This newsletter highlights many of the Foundation's activities in 2023, along with a summary of our financial position.

Pinawa Scholarships

2023 Pinawa Foundation Scholarship (\$1,500)

Pinawa Hospital - \$550 for privacy screens, observation room curtains, patient hygiene products


