2024-2025 Highlights

- Grants in 2024, including directed donations, were \$187,979.
- The Foundation added \$101,818 to our endowment during Philanthropy Week in November. We collected \$38,000 in donations at other times in 2024 as well.
- Received our first Thomas Sill Grant for Pinawa to be disbursed in 2025 (\$22,903).
- Community Project Month in 2025 Raised \$113,400 for 17 projects.
- Received over \$16,600 from the Winnipeg Foundation for administrative and programming costs.

2024-2025 Highlights

- Mallery McKay received the Pinawa Foundation Scholarship (\$1,500). Celeste Fontaine was awarded the Gladys Guthrie Memorial Scholarship (\$2,000).
- Completed another successful year for our Youth in Philanthropy program. A total of \$3,000 was distributed by the students to 6 projects.
- Provided directed donations to the Christmas Hamper Committee of \$10,400.

Thomas Sill Foundation

- Founded in 1987 through the last will of Thomas Sill, a chartered accountant from Manitoba.
- Provided support for charitable initiatives throughout Manitoba.
- At the end of 2023, the Thomas Sill Foundation ceased operations but aimed to continue supporting Manitoba.
- The assets of the foundation were provided to the Winnipeg Foundation to create funds that would carry on Thomas Sill's legacy of giving. The Thomas Sill Manitoba Fund at The Winnipeg Foundation was established to benefit communities within Endow Manitoba.
- Each community foundation in Manitoba will receive a grant every year to carry on Thomas SIII's good work.

Pinawa Foundation's 2025 Thomas Sill Grant

- Very pleased to announce our 2025 grant has been awarded to the Pinawa Fire Department - \$22,903
- In collaboration with the LGD Council, grant to be used to establish a fire-based medical first response program.
- The plan is to have a medically trained firefighter available to respond within minutes to life-threatening illnesses and injuries in Pinawa.
- The grant is for equipment required by the first responders.



YIP Program

- YIP helps students learn about philanthropy and helping their community by donating funds to local worthy projects.
- Pinawa Foundation, provides \$3,000 each year to Pinawa Secondary School.


