The Pinawa Foundation announced the results of our Community Project Month Fundraisers at our Annual General Meeting on June 9 2025. **17 participating groups received \$80,271.94 in donations. The Foundation matching grant was \$33,114.28 for a total of \$113,386.22 gifted to the community!**

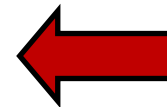
